THINK TWICE BEFORE USING YOUR DEBIT CARD

SHOULD I USE MY DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD?

This is a very common question, but also a very important one. Even though on the surface credit and debit cards seem similar there are big differences between the two methods of payment.

Debit cards are tied directly to your checking account.

This means that if your card is fraudulently used, your account has the potential to be drained in real time. Maybe even all of your funds!



Debit card fraud has a domino effect.

Since debit cards are tied directly to your checking account money that's stolen is actually gone. It might not be returned until an investigation has taken place causing a domino effect. The investigation process can take weeks. This situation could possibly leave you with a shortfall, unable to make important payments like rent, mortgage, car loans, and insurance premiums. This causes a great deal of trouble to your financial well being.

Fraudulent credit card charges, while a frustration, don't carry that same threat. They can be spotted on a monthly statement, disputed, and resolved — all without your having to pay an actual bill. The extra layer provides enormous protection.

WAYS TO REDUCE POTENTIAL DEBIT CARD FRAUD:

- 1 Do not use your debit card for online purchases
- 2 Do not tie your debit card to platforms like Venmo, CashApp, PayPal
- 3 Use your debit card only for in-person point-of-sale transactions.

Think twice and weigh the possible effects when deciding which card to use.




