CREDIT AND DEBIT CARD TRAVEL SAFETY

While you are not at any more risk for fraud when on the road than at home, the potential hassle is so much greater. Here are some tips for protecting your debit and credit cards while on the road.

Bring fewer cards and keep track of them. Take only the credit and debit cards that you expect to use, plus a backup, and keep them protected!

Don't use a debit card for purchases. Because a debit card pulls funds directly out of your account, your money is gone immediately, and it will stay gone until the fraudulent use is investigated. Limit your debit card use to cash machine withdrawals. To make purchases, pay with cash or a credit card.

Act quickly if your card is lost or stolen. For credit call: 1-800-543-5073 and for debit call: 1-888-241-2510.

ATM usage. Be careful and look out for various ATM scams and be sure to safeguard your card PIN.

Put a travel advisory on your credit union credit and debit cards. Call us at 716-630-0888 and ask that we add a travel advisory to your cards.
